Event Information:

The Garner Parks, Recreation and Cultural Resources Department is looking for civic or non-profit organizations to get involved with our biggest fall event, Goblins in the Park from 6:00 PM - 9:00 PM on Saturday, October 29th. There are 8 spots available on our Trail of Terror for your organization to be creative and bring some excitement to our event. There is an entry fee of \$25.00 per group. Entries must be turned into the Garner Parks, Recreation and Cultural Resources Department no later than Friday, September 30th. A staff member will contact you about your location on the trail on Friday, October 7th. There will be one cash prize offered for the scariest section of the Trail of Terror:

Top Prize \$500.00

*The winning organization will receive a Town of Garner issued check one week after the event.
*There must be a minimum of 5 organizations to participate for cash prize to be awarded.

Town of Garner staff will have final approval of Trail of Terror scene and design. At any time during the event, staff will have the authority to make changes to the organization's scene at their discretion.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Must provide a Certificate of Liability Insurance naming the Town of Garner as additionally insured.
2. This opportunity is only open to 501 (c) classified non-profit organizations.
3. Entry fee may be paid by cash, credit card or check made payable to the Town of Garner.
4. The setup time for this event is from 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM on Saturday, October 29th.
5. The breakdown and cleanup of your area must be completed by 12:00 PM on Sunday, October 30th.
6. Only self-sustaining structures can be used in your area, no permanent structures allowed.
7. Any structures, equipment or props must not impede on the natural environment. Example: not allowed to nail anything to a nearby tree.
8. You must provide your own power supply if your scene calls for the need of lights or other props which use electricity.
9. Organization members may jump out or follow Trail of Terror participants but may not have physical contact with any participant.
10. Organization members working at their scene must stay in their designated area.
11. While the purpose of this trail is to provide a scare, be mindful that this is a family event and refrain from anything that may be considered inappropriate or offensive.
12. No sharp or dangerous props allowed. Please use look-a-like, dull or blunt props. Example: chainsaw without the chain or foam swords and axes.
13. No open flames, firearms, alcoholic beverages or pets are allowed at any Town of Garner event.
