

GARBAGE

Green Rollout: for trash and household garbage

- ✓ Once-per-week curbside collection.
- ✓ Rollouts must be curbside by **7:00 a.m.** on your garbage day. You can also put them out the night before.
- ✓ Keep rollouts out of the street, away from mailboxes and driveways.
- ✓ No yard waste, hazardous waste, or construction debris in the rollout.
- ✓ Please keep rollouts clean.



RECYCLING

Tan Rollout: for bi-weekly recycling

See calendar for your bi-weekly schedule

Recycle:

- ✓ Aluminum, steel, bi-metal, and metal cans
- ✓ Glass bottles and jars-all colors
- ✓ Plastic jugs and bottles (milk, soft drink, and juice containers)
- ✓ Paperboard and cardboard products (cereal boxes, shoe boxes, gable top, etc.)
- ✓ Newspapers, magazines, junk mail, catalogs and all inserts
- ✓ Plastic containers # 1, 2 & 5



***Plastic bags are not allowed in the recycle containers**



Electronic Recycling Event

Saturday, February 22, 2020 8 am- 1 pm

The Town will be hosting an electronic recycling event at the Public Works Department. Please bring us all your TV's, Computers and other electronic equipment for recycling. This event takes the place of electronics being picked up during the Spring and Fall Clean-ups. Public Works Department is located at 610 Rand Mill Rd.

Current Special Collection Fees:

Trash in excess of 6 cubic yards per week (per load)	\$40.45
Bulk Waste (per item)	\$40.45
Yard Waste in excess of 6 cubic yards per week (per load)	\$17.38

YARD WASTE

Yard Waste: preparation and disposal

- ✓ Place **prepared** yard waste at the curb for weekly collection on your day of service. (Up to 6 cubic yards or approximately 20 bags)
 - ✓ Use clear plastic bags for leaves, pine straw, vines, shrub clippings, etc.
 - ✓ Residents can use a 32 gallon container for small amounts of loose yard waste (total weight less than **60 lbs.**).
 - ✓ Tie tree limbs less than 1½ inches in diameter and less than **4 foot lengths** in bundles that weigh less than **60 pounds each**.
 - ✓ Larger tree limbs must be cut in **4 foot lengths** or less with no piece weighing over **60 pounds**. Stack with the larger end toward the curb.
- ***Commercial tree company work is not eligible for pick up.**



Leaf Season

- ✓ Loose leaf season/pine straw starts **November 1st** and runs through the **end of February** on your **recycle day**.
 - ✓ Leaves and pine straw must be at the curb by **7:00 a.m.** on your day of service (**recycling day**).
 - ✓ Keep piles away from mailboxes and storm drains.
- ***No limbs, dirt, or rocks in your leaves or pine straw.**

BULK ITEMS

Bulk Waste Removal

Bulk Waste is any item that weighs more than 60 pounds or will not fit into the rollout. A special collection fee is charged for pick up.

Some examples of bulk waste are:

- ✓ Mattresses and box springs
 - ✓ Large tables or desks
 - ✓ Sofas and recliners
 - ✓ Sinks, Toilets (left in one piece)
 - ✓ Bedroom furniture-dresser, chest, headboards, etc.
 - ✓ Appliances (white goods) dryers, water heaters, washers, etc.
- * *No Refrigerators or microwaves will be picked up*

This is a great opportunity to get your house and yard looking great for the summer! Public Works will be collecting unprepared yard debris (*does not have to be bagged or bundled*), excess trash and bulky items (couch, bed, table and chairs, etc.). Items should be placed at the curb up to **one week prior** to your scheduled pick-up week. Please have your items **separated** by the following categories: Yard waste, bulky waste, Each category will be picked up by a separate truck. The Town would like to encourage you to take advantage of this free Spring Clean-up. **Please call the Public Works office before your pick-up week to schedule for a mattress to be picked up.** Please note, there are a few categories that will not be picked up; commercial waste (from tree company or contractor), appliances, paint or hazardous waste.

During our Fall Clean-Up the Town will be collecting any unprepared yard debris (does not have to be bagged or bundled) and **tires** (limit 4 rimless tires per residence). You may begin putting items out **one week** prior to your scheduled pick-up. However, the Town will **not** collect any Commercial yard debris or bulk items.
