


### WHY ARE WE DOING THIS PLAN?

In 2016, voters approved a half-cent sales tax initiative to fund transit improvements in Wake County. These improvements not only include high-capacity Bus Rapid Transit and a tripling of fixed route bus service, but also the opportunity for local municipalities to invest in transit as well. The Town of Garner is using this opportunity to embark on its first-ever local transit study. With your input, this study will help determine when, where, and how Garner is served by transit.



### WHAT IS THE SCHEDULE FOR THE PLANNING PROCESS?

The first phase of public outreach will help establish the service priorities in Garner, identify transit needs, and possible alternatives.

Garner residents will have the opportunity to weigh-in on possible route alternatives as well as other recommendations for the plan. This outreach will include a series of stakeholder meetings, community events, an online survey, and a round of pop-up informational meetings throughout Garner (advertised in advance).
